

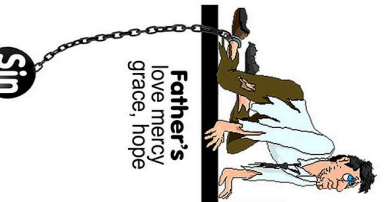
Stairway to Heaven
